A beginning guide for humble service

<u>Model Humble Service</u>: servants are humble by nature. Let your kids see you performing acts of service to your neighbors, to your church, and family members. It is never too early to show your kids and help them understand we are servants of God. (**Mark 9:35**)

Raise A Team Player: acknowledging the thoughts and feelings of others is a part of humility. Teach them to be sensitive to those around them, teach them to see the needs of others around them. Encourage your children to approach school and church relationships with that same spirit of teamwork. Talk with them about how they can help a classmate who is struggling how they might help bring out the best in others around them.

Infuse A Teachable Spirit: you must model a teachable spirit. Let your kids see you looking for help through reading, listening, or seeking direction from others. Our kids are watching every move we make. If they witness hypocrisy, they'll begin to disregard what we say. Our children will become what we are — so we must start becoming what we want them to be.
