

## Amplify Conference 2024 Featured Breakout Leading Your Church to Mission with Kevin G. Harney

All the forces of hell and human frailty work against the mission of Jesus. It will not "just happen." This is why our Savior said, "Go!" "Make!" Baptize!" "Teach!" And this is why we need our Lord with us every step of the way. If we are going to see a lasting movement of discipleship that leads believers on mission with the Savior, it will mean that we, "Deny self!" "Die daily!" And, "Follow faithfully!"

I don't know how that sounds to you, but that sounds really hard to me.

## Five examples of creating a culture of sustained mission for the glory of Jesus:

- 1. Self-Leadership and the Law of Love!
  - A Biblical truth: If our love dies, so does our vision. If we are going to lead a church on the mission of Jesus, it will mean loving God, the Church, and the lost with ever-increasing passion. This demands relentless soul care and growth in holiness. Biblical Text: Matthew 22:34-40 and Psalm 139 Ministry Resource (Book): Leadership from the Inside Out
  - A real-life example: Words from a local church leader...
  - A *practical challenge*: Tend your soul and check your love levels on a regular basis (and do this in community)

- 2. Leading Your Board (and Other Volunteer Leaders) on Mission.
  - A Biblical truth: Jesus' last words should be our first priority! We need to relentlessly infuse spiritual growth that leads to evangelism in every ministry and person in the local church. Biblical Text: Matthew 28:16-20

## 3. Leading Your Staff on a Mission of Discipleship and Evangelism.

 A Biblical truth: Understand and expect four generations of discipleship. Every believer needs people who are investing in their spiritual life. They also need to be stewards of their own growth in faith and mission. Then, every believer should be investing in the spiritual growth of the next generation of believers who will be equipped to do the same!
 Biblical Text: 2 Timothy 2:2

- A practical challenge: Start with you! Model a 2-2-2 Lifestyle and teach your key leaders to do the same.

  - A Biblical truth: Keep evangelism on the front burner of your local church ministry (on every level) until Jesus returns or brings you home.
    Biblical Text: Matthew 9:35-38
    Ministry Resource (Book): Organic Outreach for Ordinary People: Sharing Good News Naturally
  - **A real-life example**: Words from a leader in a multicultural and relentlessly evangelist church in the LA area...
  - A practical challenge: Don't let evangelism be a fad, "ministry emphasis," or an afterthought. Instead, make it central in every part of your ministry.
- 5. Keeping Mission in Mind in Times of Ministry Transition.
  - A Biblical truth: Times of change and transition
    Biblical Text: The Book of Judges...see the cycle
    Ministry Resource (Book): Organic Outreach for Churches: Infusing
    Evangelistic Passion in Your Local Congregation

- **A practical challenge**: Recognize and prepare for off-ramps and roadblocks to staying focused on the mission of the church.
